The vast majority of Jewish culture is firmly rooted in Halacha, and students will be able to appreciate the foundations of the religion though gaining a broad knowledge of both the practical laws and related concepts. Judaism is a communal religion, and many obligations are rooted in Halacha.

BIG IDEAS

1. Customs and Traditions are grounded in Halach. 2. Knowledge of the laws is necessary for fulfilling communal obligations. 3. Proper communication between student and teacher and among peers is essential for learning. 4. Examining and analyzing text is key to gaining a full understand of the text and its message.
