Service learning is important as it helps develop character and has a positive impact on community. Reflecting on experiences helps one to develop character and personal identity.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Students receive instruction via classroom instruction, exam week workshops, guest speakers, monthly transition meetings, and field trips.
