NATIONAL GEOGRAPHIC KIDS (GALE)

Grades K-7

tools—on a student-friendly platform that makes learning easily accessible.

4CANOES Grades K-12



4Canoes is a Canadian-created set of digital resources; sharing stories, traditional knowledge, and experiences of Indigenous communities across Canada and North America in magazine format. Included in the growing collection are student versions of

the magazines, along with student workbooks and educator guides.

There are several 'talking' e-books featuring Indigenous spoken language and the English translation. Included is access to *Residential Schools with the Words and Images of Survivors* (Loyie, Brissenden, Spears) created for ages 12-18 years, and Richard Wagemese's *Indian Horse*.

KNOW BC Grades K-12

KnowBC is a set of encyclopedia and non-fiction publications focused on the history and natural history of British Columbia. Formerly Harbour Publishing, the online version includes many of the original print titles which continue to be updated and expanded. Numerous major Pacific Northwest resources are included in the collection.

NATIONAL FILM BOARD (NFB)

Grades K-12



The *National Film Board* is a rich collection of documentaries, animated films, interactive productions, and hundreds of short films in English and French. With study guides and learning bundles, there are three key themes: environment and sustainability, Indigenous voices and reconciliation, and diversity and inclusion.
